He also talked about the District Rehabilitation Centre and the CRC which work specifically for the Disabled and their families. The Director of OBS Fr. Nabin Roshan Lakra reiterated the importance of the work carried out by the community workers and thanked them for their hard work and dedicating their precious time in attending the Training. He also sought wholehearted support from Anganwadi workers in the venture of OBS-CBM for humanitarian cause.

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### Miscellaneous

Oisho Bani Society (OBS) with the support of Steyler Mission held seed fair for the farmers at Janthum in Dhalai district. ## Medical Help

### 1. Medical Help for Nur Amin



Nur Amin, a welder from Lakhimpur, suffered serious injuries to his head, ear, neck, and backbone when a wall collapsed while he was repairing his house roof. Due to financial difficulties, he was unable to seek medical treatment. Understanding his critical condition and urgent need for assistance, he was provided with immediate financial support of Rs. 15,000/- to ensure he received the necessary medical care. This timely help enabled him to begin his treatment without delay, offering him a chance at recovery. His case highlights the importance of

financial aid in emergency situations, ensuring that those in need receive proper medical attention.

### 2. Mahesh Dako's Wife's Treatment



Mahesh Dako, a daily wage laborer from Naricmp, lives with his wife, Pokio Dako, and their young son studying in LKG. Unfortunately, his wife was critically ill with Hepatitis B, severely damaging her liver. She required urgent treatment in Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh, which involved significant medical expenses. However, due to financial constraints, the family struggled to afford the costs. Recognizing their plight, Oisho Bani Society

extended a helping hand by providing financial assistance of Rs. 15,000/- to support Mrs. Pokio Dako's treatment, offering much-needed relief to the distressed family during their difficult time.

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### 3. Wankimon Pamblang for Daughter's Treatment



Wankimon Pamblang, a farmer, has been struggling to provide medical treatment for his one-year-old daughter, Iska Mary Pamblang, who has been diagnosed with soft tissue vascular malformation since she was two months old. She has been receiving treatment at Nazareth Hospital, Shillong, requiring significant financial resources.

Despite their best efforts, the family has exhausted their savings. In this difficult time, Wankimon sought assistance, and the Oisho Bani Society promptly extended support by donating Rs. 20,000/-. This generous help has brought immense relief and renewed hope to the family. Their gratitude towards the society is immeasurable, as the support ensures Iska Mary's treatment continues, giving her a chance for a healthier future.

### 4. Mr. Biplab Paul



Mr. Biplab Paul is a resident of Agartala, Tripura. He is a 11<sup>th</sup> standard student studying in Agartala. In the month of January, 2025, Mr. Biplab Paul met with a fatal bike accident. Thereafter he is bed ridden and unable to attend the school activities. Father of Mr. Biplab

approached Oisho Bani Society for medical treatment. As the family is poor and depending on daily wages. They do not have any job or bank balance to treat the boy. While approaching to Oisho Bani Society, the president of the society approved Rs. 15,000/- for the medical treatment. The amount was transferred to their account on 4<sup>th</sup> February, 2025. It was done with the approval

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of governing body members. The boy was already undergoing treatment in G.B. Hospital and spent much of their amount for medicines.

The help was small in amount but it was a great relief for the family on timely help. The family is grateful to the society for such humanitarian act.

## Educational Help

### 1. Jia Debbarma



**Jia Debbarma**, a Class II student, comes from a poor family and lives with her mother and elder sister. Her father left the family a few years ago, leaving her mother as the sole breadwinner. She struggled to support her children's education due to financial hardships. Unable to pay school fees or buy textbooks for Jia, the family faced significant difficulties. Upon request, they received Educational Help of Rs. 10,000/-, from Oisho Bani Society which provided much-needed relief. This assistance eased their burden, ensuring Jia could

continue her education without interruption, bringing hope and support to the struggling family.

### 2. Rubel Debbarma



**Rubel Debbarma** belongs to a poor family where both his parents are differently abled. His father is deaf and mute, while his mother is visually impaired. Additionally, his father often suffers from illness, making it difficult to support the family. Despite these challenges, the father works as a daily wage laborer to help sustain his family. However, due to financial difficulties, they were unable to afford his school admission fees and textbooks. Understanding their struggle, Oisho Bani Society extended educational assistance of Rs. 10,000/-,

providing crucial support for Rubel's education and offering hope to his family during their hardship.

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### 3. Brijesh Debbarma



**Brijesh Debbarma**, a resident of Katalutma, Kamalpur in Tripura's Dhalai district, is pursuing a BSc in Nursing at Prajwal College of Nursing, Bengaluru. Recently, he lost his father, who was the sole breadwinner of the family, leading to severe financial difficulties. Struggling to pay his tuition and exam fees, he sought help from the president of Oisho Bani Society. Understanding his situation, the society promptly provided educational assistance of Rs. 20,000/-. This support eased his financial burden, allowing him to continue his education without interruption and bringing much-needed relief to his grieving family.

### 4. Mr. Satish Debbarma



Mr. Satish Debbarma resides in Agartala, Tripura, where he earns his livelihood as a farmer, striving tirelessly to support his aged parents, wife, and three children. Despite his best efforts, meeting the financial needs of his family, especially his son's education, has been challenging. Understanding the family's circumstances and the importance of education for their future, Valentine raised the matter before the governing body of the society. Moved by family's well-being, the Council swiftly approved Rs. 20,000 to cover the educational expenses on 24<sup>th</sup> Dec, 2024. This grant provided crucial support, alleviating the financial burden for studies uninterrupted.

## Social Help

### 1. Marchila Basumatary as social help for house repair



Marchila Basumatary, a resident of Udalguri district in Assam, recently lost her husband after a prolonged illness, leaving her to care for

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their five children alone. Struggling with health issues herself, she faces numerous challenges in managing household duties and ensuring her children's education. Their family also lacked a proper home, making their situation even more difficult. In response to her request for help, Oisho Bani Society provided her with ₹20,000/- as financial aid to repair her house. This assistance brought much-needed relief, allowing her to improve their living conditions and provide a safer environment for her children.

## 2. Tunu Debbarmma



Tunu Debbarmma, a resident of Kamranga in the Dholai district of Tripura, has been facing significant hardships since her husband abandoned her and their two children. As the sole provider for her family, she struggles to meet both her children's needs and manage household responsibilities. Additionally, they lacked a proper home, further worsening their living conditions.

Recognizing her distress, Tunu sought assistance from the president of Oisho Bani Society. Understanding her plight, the society extended financial support of ₹20,000 to help her repair her house. This aid provided her with much-needed relief, enabling her to create a safer and more stable living environment for her children. The support from Oisho Bani Society not only improved their housing conditions but also brought hope and encouragement to Pushpa during her difficult times. Such acts of social assistance play a crucial role in uplifting vulnerable individuals and fostering community well-being.

## 3. Pushpa Rani Debbarmma



Pushpa Rani Debbarmma, a resident of Shirampur village in Kamalpur, Dhalai district, Tripura, has been struggling with severe financial difficulties for

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a long time. Her husband's prolonged illness has left her as the sole caretaker of the family, responsible for both his medical expenses and their children's education. She takes up daily wage labor whenever possible, but the lack of a stable income makes it difficult to meet their basic needs. Their home, a fragile bamboo-thatched structure, is in a deteriorated condition, adding to their hardships. In desperation, she sought assistance from Oisho Bani Society to repair her house. The financial aid provided much-needed relief, easing her burden and improving their living conditions, offering her a sense of hope amidst adversity.

#### 4. Mrs. Shephali Marak



Mrs. Shephali Marak resides in Udaipur, Agartala. Her living condition is very miserable and challenging. Determined to improve their living condition, they had begun constructing a small house, but their progress was halted due to financial constraints. Realizing the urgent need for stable housing, Mrs. Shephali Marak approached Oisho Bani

Society for assistance. Understanding the family's plight, the Regional Council swiftly intervened and approve Rs. 20,000/- in social help to complete the construction their home. Based on that Oisho Bani Society on 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 transferred the amount to their account.

#### 5. Mr. Sumit Halam



Mr. Sumit Halam resides in Ambassa, Tripura. His living condition was very miserable and challenging. Determined to improve their living condition, they had begun constructing a small house, but their progress was halted due to financial

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constraints. Realizing the urgent need for stable housing, Mr. Sumit Halam approached Oisho Bani Society for assistance. Understanding the family's plight, the Regional Council swiftly intervened and approve Rs. 40,000/- (Rs. 15,000 +Rs. 25,000) in social help to complete the construction their home. Based on the approval Oisho Bani Society on and 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2024 and 4<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2025, transferred the amount to their account.

## **Flood Relief**

### **Flood Emergency in Tripura 2024:**

The relentless rainfall on August 18, 2024, triggered the severe flood and landslides across the various districts causing humanitarian crisis in a large way. The disaster claimed many lives, injuries, missing of many individuals and displacement of many families. Knowing and experiencing the plight of the poor people at this flood time, we the OISHO BANI SOCIETY the registered NGO in North East India wanted to intervene in the struggles of the people by carrying out some relief work for the people who are finding difficult to meet their both ends. As per the project proposal distribution of dry ration kits, kitchen appliances and provisions to 800 families were planned have been materialised.

We are happy to place in record that we were able to realise all the measures that we had planned to take up, Due to more request for dry ration from the people we adjusted the budgets of other activities and managed to reach more families with dry rations.

As per our project proposal we had following objectives. They are:

- a. Distribution of dry ration kits
- b. Distribution of kitchen appliances
- c. Administrative Expenses
- d. Contingency Expenses.

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All the above objectives have been successfully realised. The dry ration distribution helped the people to meet their food expenses at least for few days. The kitchen appliances, blankets, mosquito nets are very essential for long term usage. The details of the distribution:

## Narrative Report

### Flood Fury in Tripura in August, 2024

Month of August, 2024, Tripura experienced heavy to very heavy rainfall in many districts. The relentless rainfall triggered severe flooding and landslides across the state of Tripura. There were unprecedented humanitarian crisis claiming several lives, injuries and devastations. On 21<sup>st</sup> August 2024, the state experienced heavy downpours with West Tripura receiving 182 mm, Khowai 157.60 mm and Gomati 153.10 mm of rain. The flood has impacted approximately 17 lakh people across 8 districts of Tripura. Thousands of people were put up in various relief camps set up by the district administrations.

There was a huge agricultural damage with approximately 5,000 hectares of vegetables and 1.20 lakh hectares of paddy fields completely submerged. The infrastructure such as roads, bridges, electricity services and water supply suffered severe disruptions. According to the report as many as 1,396 houses had been partially damaged, 184 houses completely destroyed and 368 houses have been severely impacted.

### JPIC Response for Flood victims in Tripura

During the flood situation in Tripura, India Guwahati Regional JPIC played a vital role in alleviating the sufferings of flood victims at various localities. The JPIC coordinator along the local leaders visited and assessed the affected area for necessary help. There were few localities selected for the relief purposes such as Khwumlung, Champaknagar, Agartala, Khayerpur and Teliamura.

#### 1. Khwumlung (19<sup>th</sup> September, 2024)



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Khwumlung is a town in the West Tripura district in the state of Tripura. It is the headquarters and the largest town of the Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council (TTAADC). Khwumlung comes under Belbari block. It is the hub of tribal area and predominantly

debbarma tribe live. Khwumlung was badly affected by the flood and many lost their crops, households and livelihood. As a part of JPIC concern, Oisho Bani Society came forward to help them with dry ration. About 100 received the dry ration packets. Although it was a meager help but reached out to them at the right moment. One could see the rays of hope and happiness even at this painful moment.

## 2. Champaknagar (19<sup>th</sup> September)



Champaknagar is a village in Jirania Block in West Tripura District of Tripura State, India. It is located 24 km towards East from District headquarters Agartala. 6 km from Jirania, 25 km from state capital Agartala. People of Champaknagar

depend on paddy cultivation, vegetables, animal husbandry etc for their livelihood.

The recent flood devoured their crops and livelihood. As a result, people of Champaknagar area remained helpless situation. Having assessed the flood situation in Champaknagar, JPIC coordinator along with the local



leaders reached out with kitchen kits and clothe items. People gathered in Champaknagar Pastoral centre to receive their relief materials. The relief materials were distributed to the needy and deserving after thorough screening. There were 100 beneficiaries who received the relief materials kits.

### 3. Khumpuilung & Tuimarang (19<sup>th</sup> September, 2024)

**Khumpuilung:** Khumpuilung is one of the far-flung villages in Tripura. Hardly people know about this village. This village comes under Sipahijala District of Tripura state. People are poor and remained illiterate. They depend on agriculture for their livelihood. There are Hrankhawl and Jamatia in this locality. They speak their local dialects and Kokborok. They have very less contact with the township. Transportation and communications have also not much developed in this area.



During the flood, Khumpuilung village was submersed in the flood water. The river changed its course and flew through the village causing enormous damages. Many lost their houses, cattle, crops,

households etc. They were forced to evacuate from the village and took shelter in their relatives and shelter homes. As the water subsided slowly, they came back to their homes but everything was damaged due to flood water. However, at this juncture the JPIC coordinator with the help of local leaders reached out by giving away the relief materials to the needy and deserving people.



**Tuimairang:** Tuimarang village comes under the TTAADC. It is inhabited by indigenous people. They speak their local dialect and some of them

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understand Bangla language as well. It is one of the tiny villages in a remote area. People in this area depend heavily on agriculture and monsoon. They are not much educated as the education institutions are far away from the village. The transportation and communications have not developed in the village.

Tuimairang also faced lots of difficulties and struggles during the flood fury. The local leaders requested to Oisho Bani Society to reach out to them during the flood. The JPIC coordinator with the help of local leaders reached out with relief materials to the people of this locality. They were highly appreciative of such humanitarian service during the disaster.

#### 4. Teliamura (20<sup>th</sup> September and 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2024)



Teliamura is a town and a Municipal Council in Khowai district in the state of Tripura. It is on National Highway No. 08 of India. It is also the headquarters of the recently included sub-division of Teliamura. It is 45 km from Agartala, Capital of Tripura, 35

km from Khowai and 42 km from Ambassa. The Administrative set up of the district consists of 6 Blocks and 3 Revenue Circles and 19 Tehsil Offices. The location of Khowai District Head Quarter is at Khowai Office tilla. In the locality Bengali and Kokborok both languages are spoken.



In the recent flood the rivulet at Teliamura swell to the embankment causing flood fury into the town area. Flood water overflow from the drainage and entered the houses. Due to the overflow of rivulet the whole

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town came under the flood water. People were forced to evacuate their houses and kept in the shelter homes till the water level subsided. JPIC coordinator with the help of local leaders reached out to the needy and deserving people of the locality. The beneficiaries received utensils, buckets, mugs, plates etc for the kitchen materials. They were highly appreciative of such humanitarian service at the moment of difficulties and pain.

## 5. Kunjaban (23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2024)



Kunjaban is located in West Tripura District of Tripura state. The locality covers mostly the urban area. Since it is an urban area, it is densely populated area. There are both rich and poor live together.

In Kunjaban locality one can find rich as well as poor. Among the poor they depend on daily wages for their livelihood. Daily wages like house hold works, cleaning of drainages, manual work, rickshaw pullers, roadside vendors etc. They are the most vulnerable people in Kunjaban area. During the recent flood the working-class people were mostly affected and became victims of the natural disaster. The JPIC coordinator along with the local leaders mobilized the flood victims and distributed dry ration at Oisho Bani Niketan, Kunjaban.

## 6. Agartala and Old Agartala (26<sup>th</sup> November, 2024)



Agartala is the capital of Tripura. The state administrative office known as secretariat is located in Agartala. This also comes under West Tripura district. The Old Agartala comes under Agartala Division which is located in West Tripura district of Tripura State. Old

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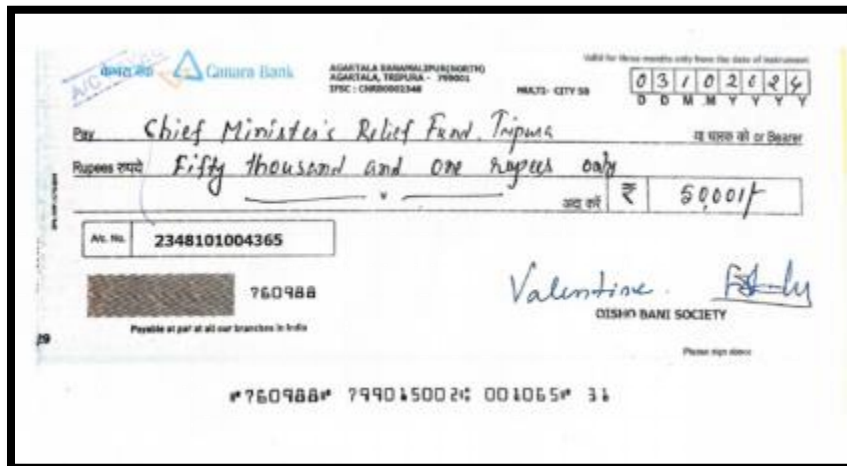
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Agartala is dominated by Begnali people and they speak Bengali. There are large population live under poverty and depend on daily wages for their survivals.

The recent flood had affected Old Agartala causing lots of damages to houses and property. Many people from Old Agartala area came forward asking for help. The JPIC coordinator along with the local leaders assessed the situation and reached out to the most deserving and needy people in the locality with dry ration kits. People were very happy to receive the relief materials.



## Tripura Chief Minister's Relief Fund for Flood Relief



Contribution was sought for Tripura Chief Minister's Relief Fund for the assistance of flood victims and displaced during natural disaster. Many NGOs, FBOs, institutions and individuals came forward towards the

On the humanitarian ground Oisho Bani Society, in solidarity with the flood victims and displaced contributed Rs. 50,001/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand and One). Nabin Roshan Lakra and Dr. Pranab Paul, on behalf of Oisho Bani Society handed over the cheque to Chief Minister, Dr. Manik Shaha on 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2024.

#### 4. Staff Residence at Kamranga

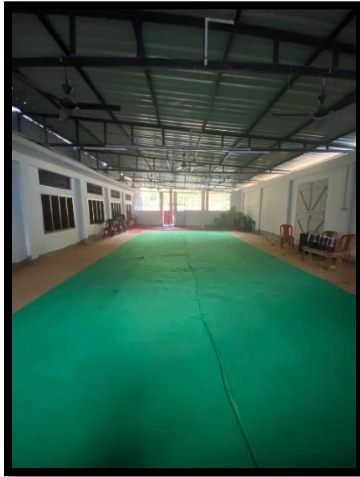
